At Radisson Hotel Group (RHG), the welfare of animals raised for food is a high priority, in particular as it relates to food served in its hotels worldwide.

Commitment

RHG is committed to work towards sourcing all its eggs from cage free sources globally. This includes eggs and the use of egg products. RHG is providing its hotels with educational materials and cage free egg directories for procurement purposes, where available.

Reporting

RHG remains committed to transparency and accuracy in reporting progress on our transition towards this goal since our initial commitment taken in 2019. For hotels that share data across our 1,000-property portfolio, including a significant number of franchisees, RHG continue working toward the most comprehensive and accurate data possible.

RHG's global sustainability KPIs and results are updated annually and published in RHG's Responsible Business Report, with next update planned for the end of April 2026. This report will include current actions and further plans.

Cage free egg status

Based on the full year reporting of 2024, 234 RHG properties are using eggs from cage free chickens.
