

Thinking of travelling to Croatia?



5 entry requirement options:

We cannot wait to welcome you to our beautiful country and are dedicated to keeping you, our people and other visitors as safe as possible, so you can explore with peace of mind.

To support this we ask that you fulfil and evidence **1 of the following 5** criteria to be allowed access to Croatia.



A **negative PCR** (taken 72 hours before arrival at the border) or **antigen** test taken (48 hours before arrival).



A **vaccination certificate** showing final dose taken more than 14 days ago.



Proof of recovery from Covid more than 11 days and less than 180 days ago.



Proof of recovery and first dose of vaccination more than 11 days and less than 6 months ago.



Pay for a test on arrival and remain in self-isolation until a negative result.

Visiting from outside of the EU?



Don't forget, you will also need to show evidence that you own property in Croatia or have paid for accommodation, be that in a hotel, camp site, private rental, boat or other tourism provider.

A few things to note...



All tests taken and used as supporting evidence of a positive or negative result must be recognized by European Union.



All children under the age of 12 are exempt from providing test results should their parent or guardian fulfil the requirements.
